





In You Be Daddy, a tired daddy lets his son take a turn being the parent at bedtime.


Told with humor and heart, these stories have become favorites with both parents and children at bedtime.

A roaring nighttime thunderstorm, the first day of preschool, and a doctor's visit encourage young readers to forge their own paths of strength in times of distress.




